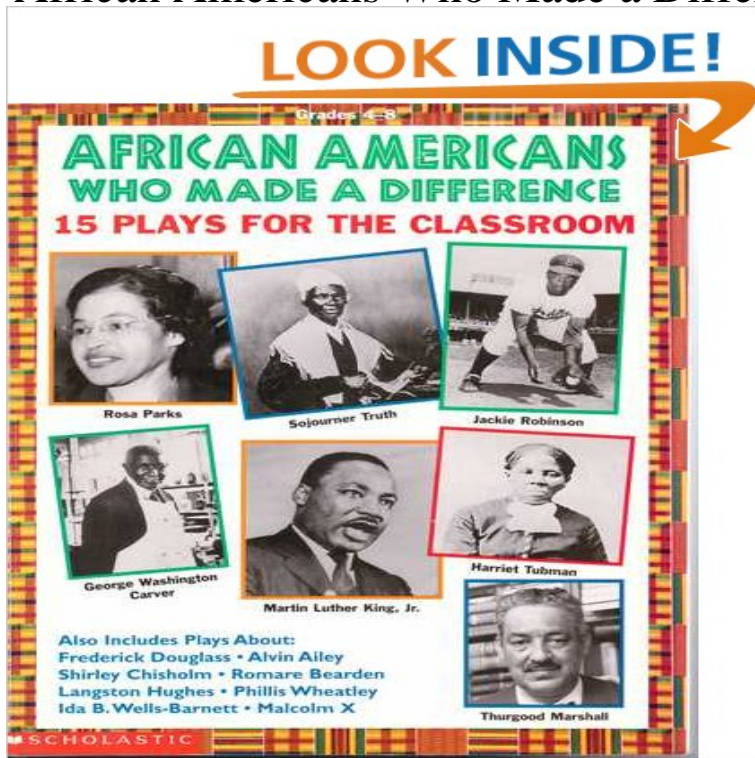


African Americans Who Made a Difference (Grades 4-8)
