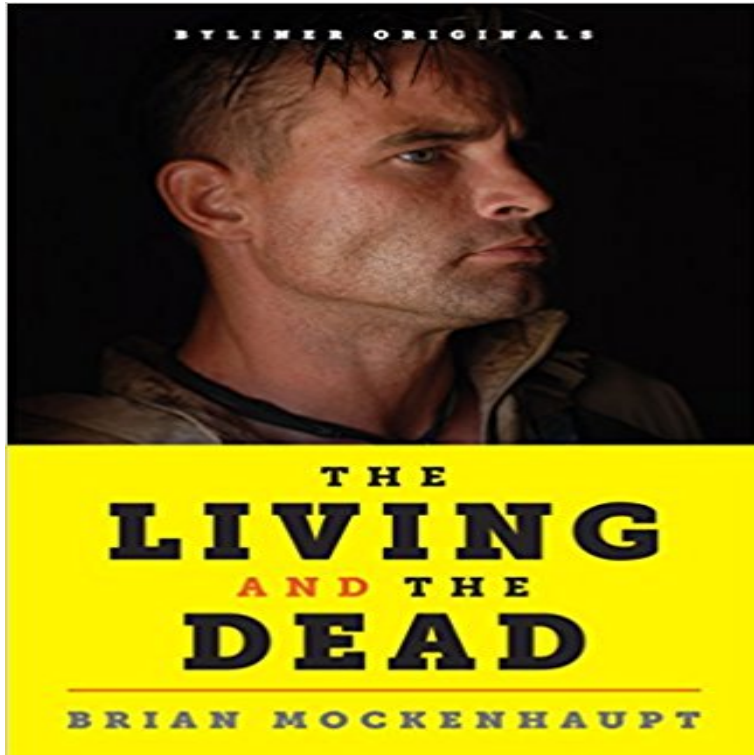


# The Living and the Dead: War, Friendship, and the Battles that Never End
