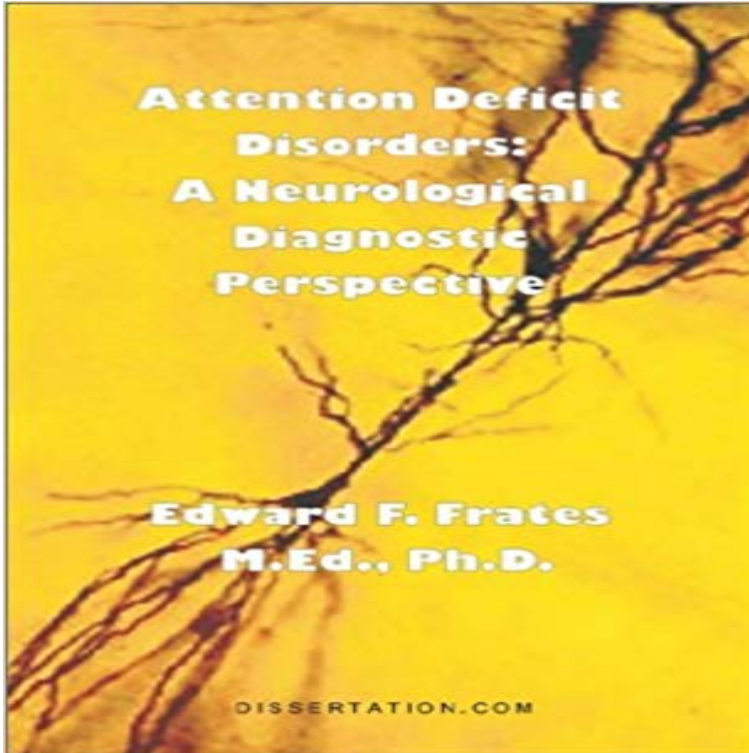


Attention Deficit Disorders: A Neurological Diagnostic Perspective
