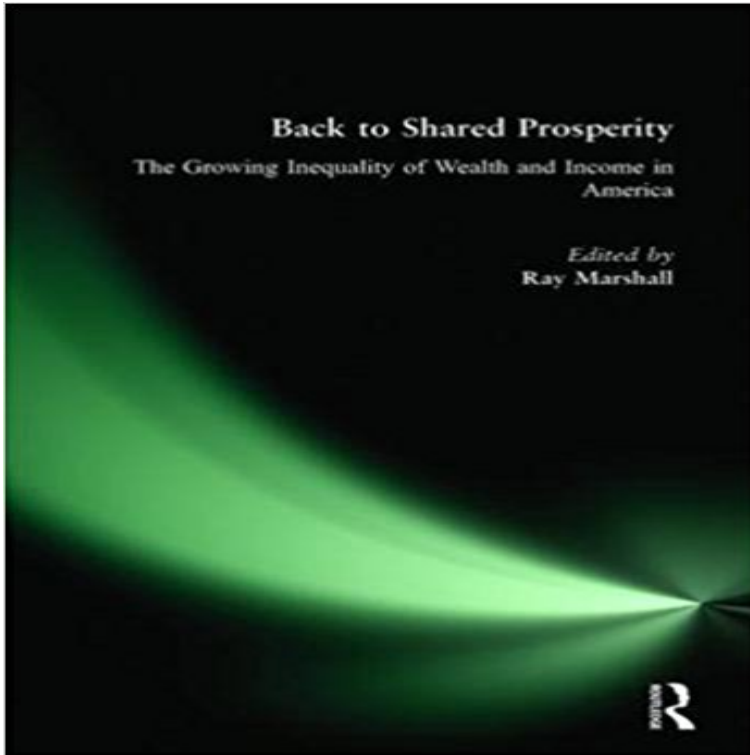


Back to Shared Prosperity: The Growing Inequality of Wealth and Income in America
