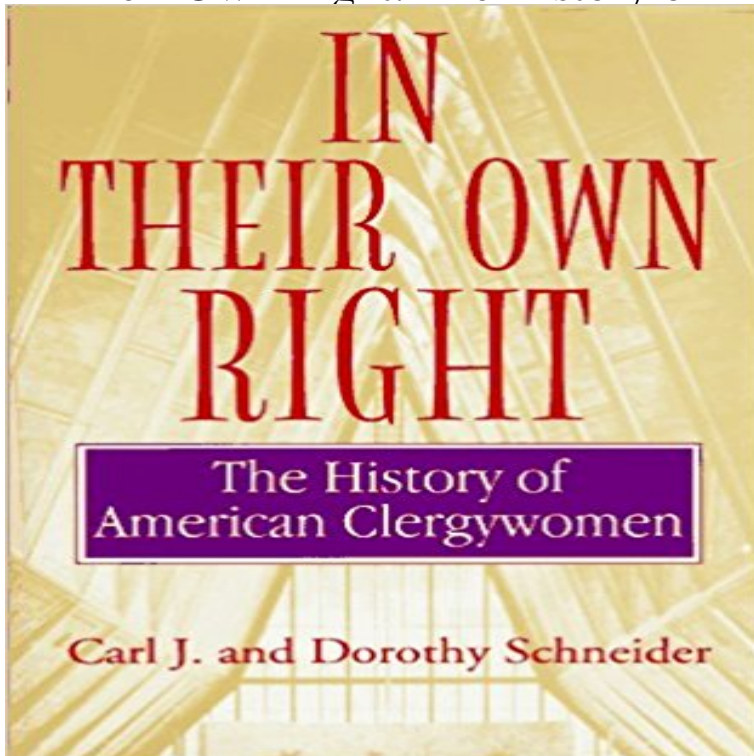


## In Their Own Right: The History of American Clergywomen
