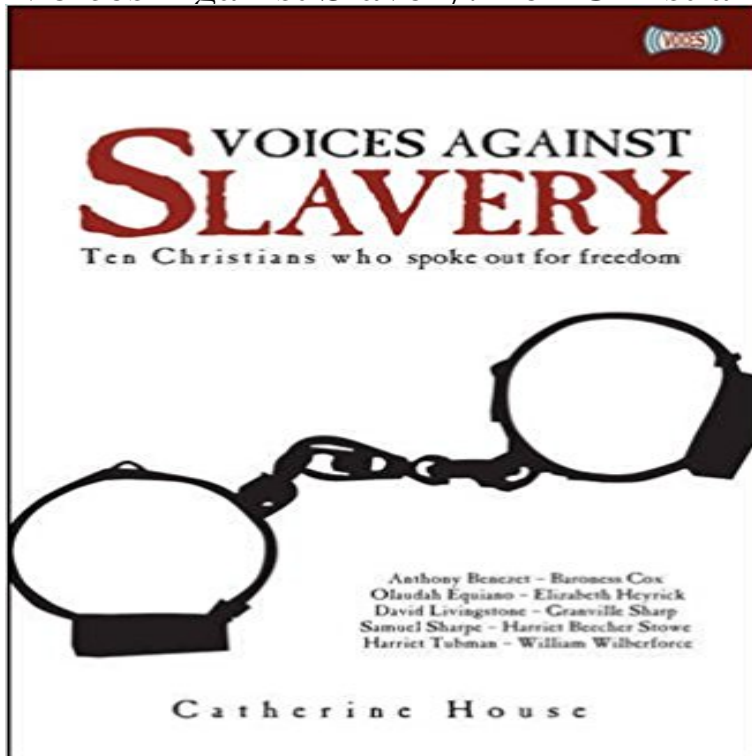


Voices Against Slavery: Ten Christians who spoke out for freedom
