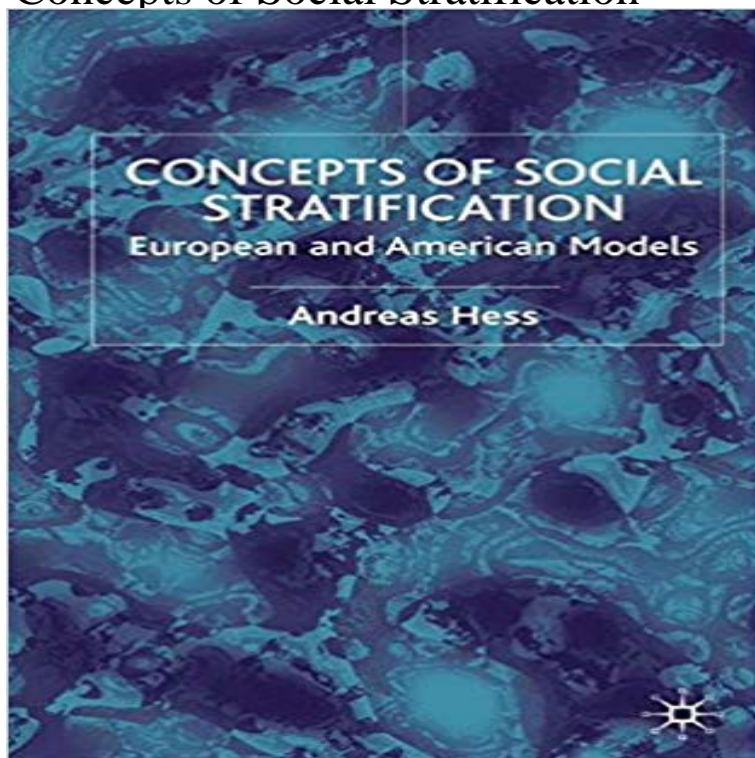


## Concepts of Social Stratification
