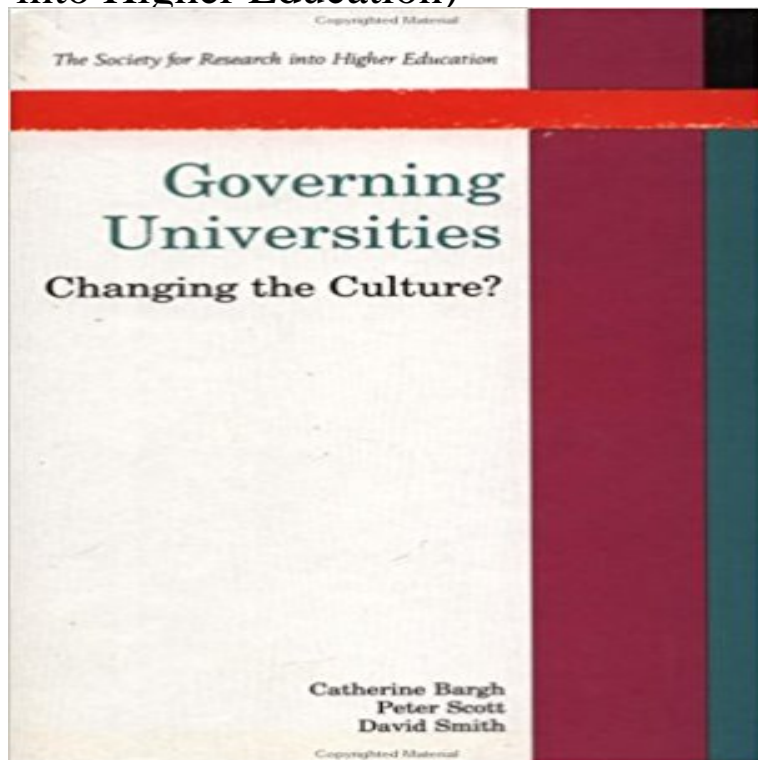


Governing Universities: Changing the Culture? (Society for Research into Higher Education)
