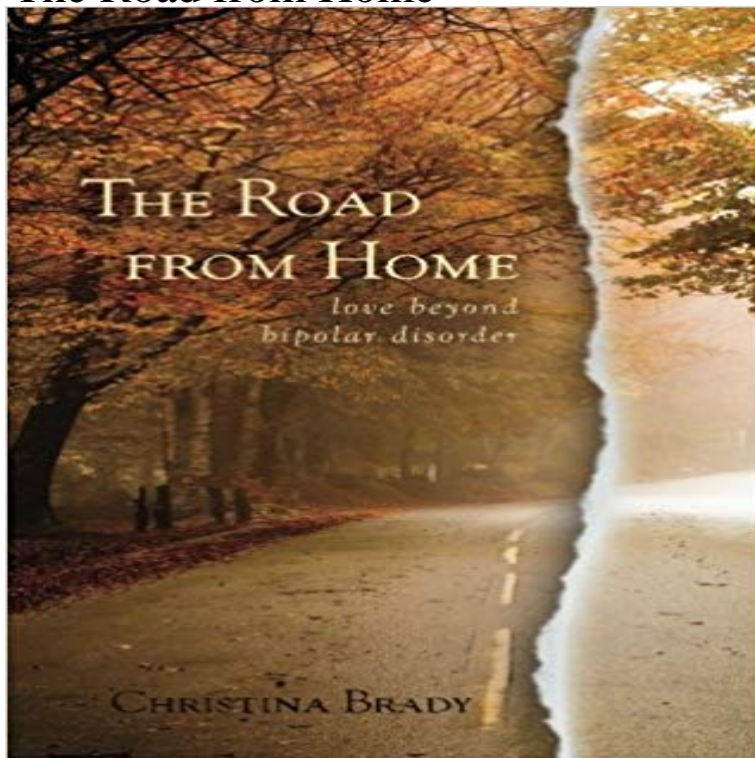


## The Road from Home
