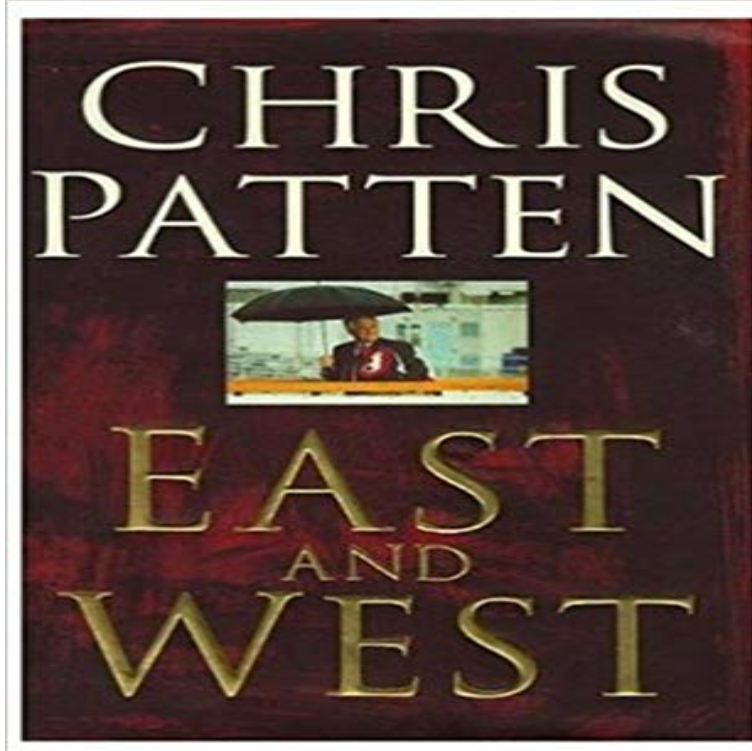


East and West: China, Power and the Future of Asia
