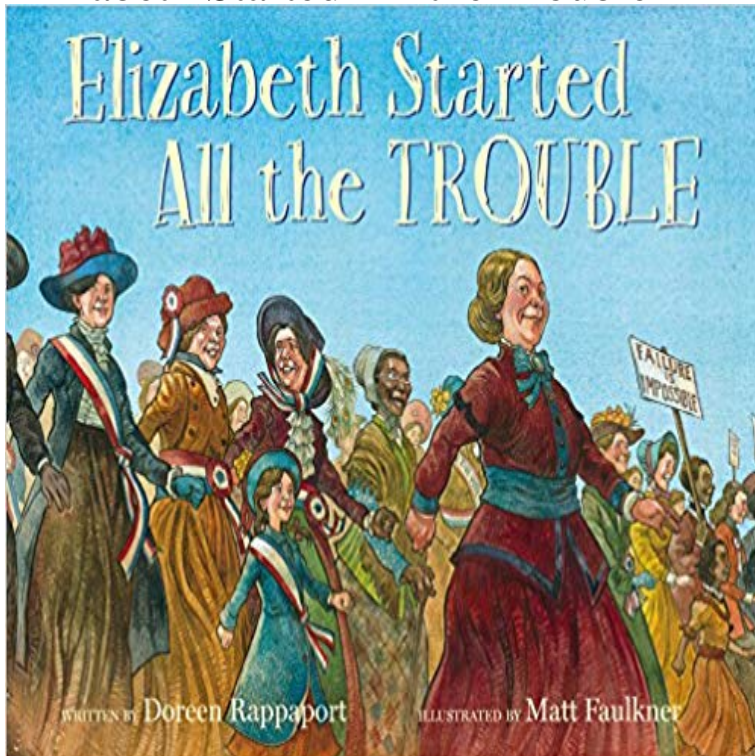


Elizabeth Started All the Trouble
