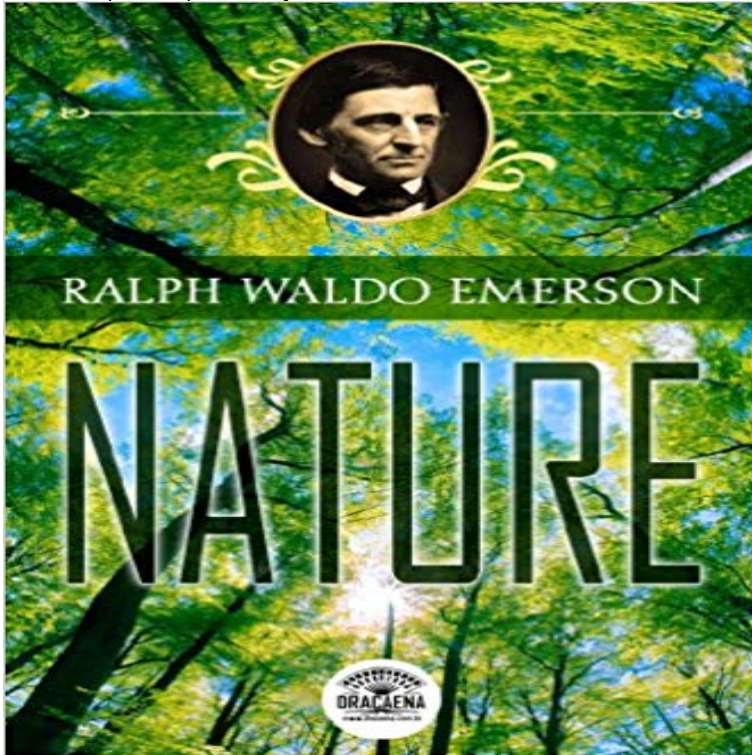


Essays by Ralph Waldo Emerson - Nature
