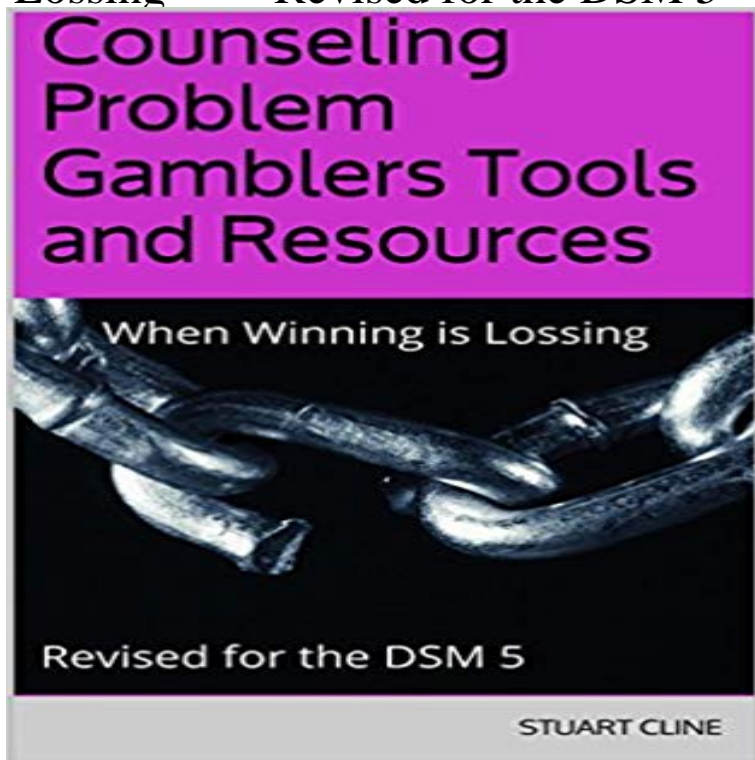


# Counseling Problem Gamblers Tools and Resources: When Winning is Lossing Revised for the DSM 5
