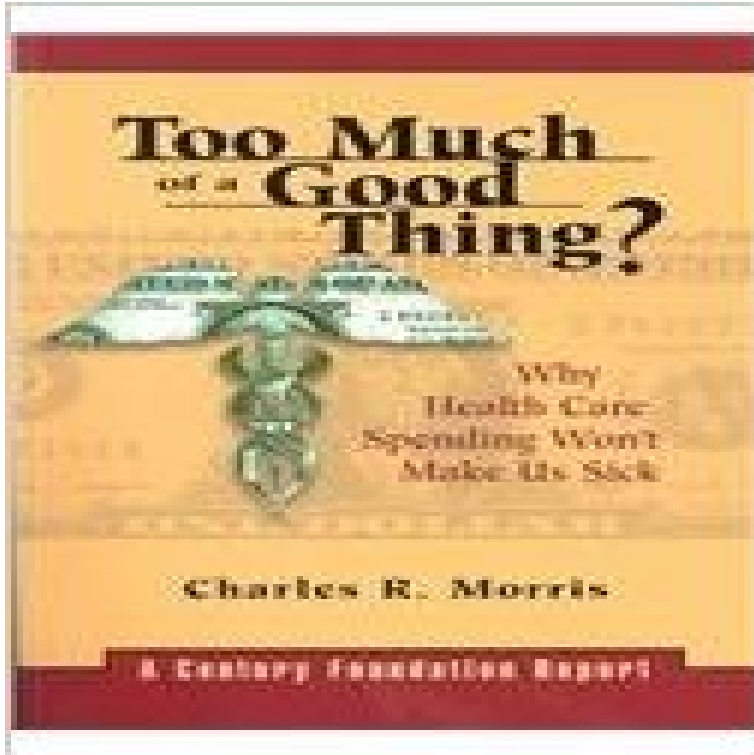


# Too Much of a Good Thing: Why Health Care Spending wont Make Us Sick
