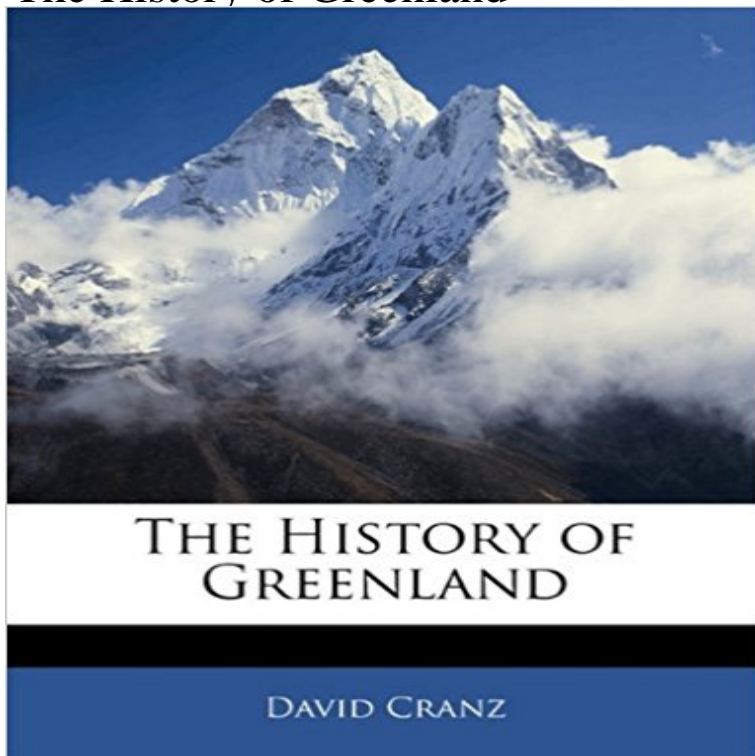


The History of Greenland
