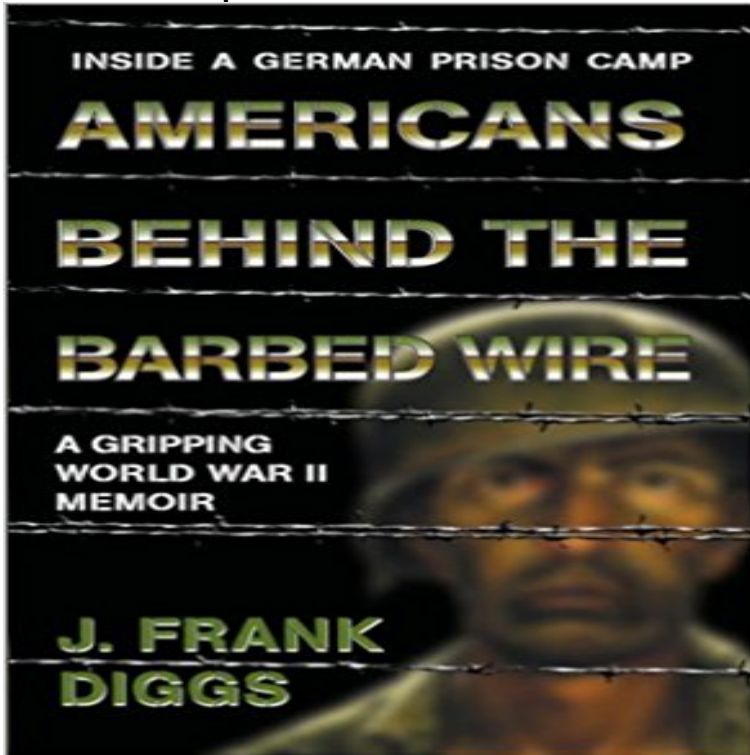


## Americans Behind the Barbed Wire: World War II: Inside a German POW Camp
