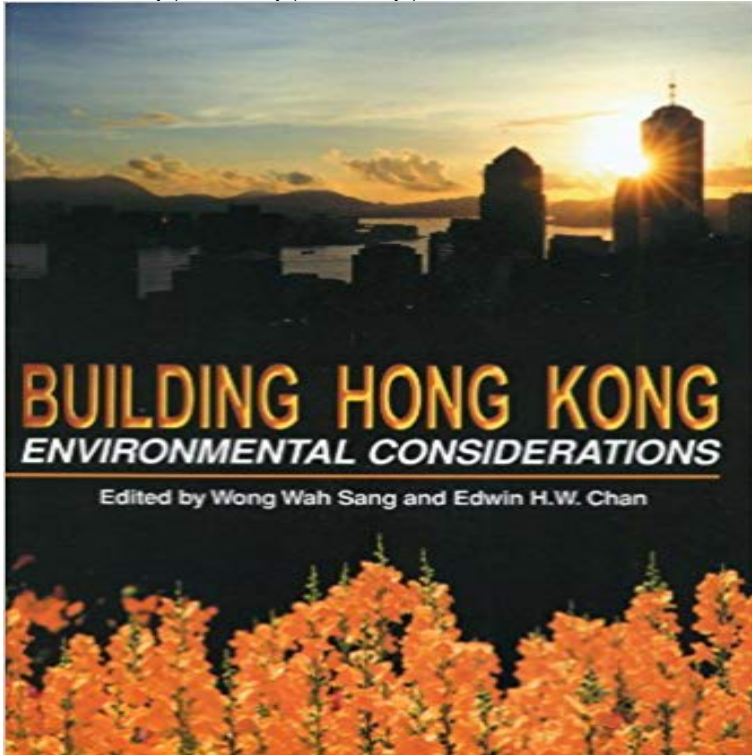


## Building Hong Kong: Environmental Considerations
