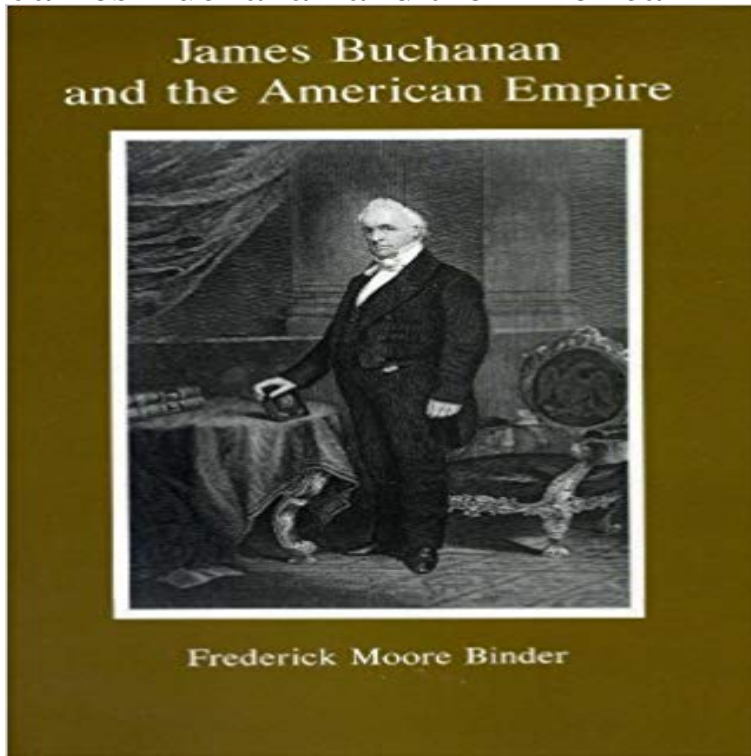


James Buchanan and the American Empire
