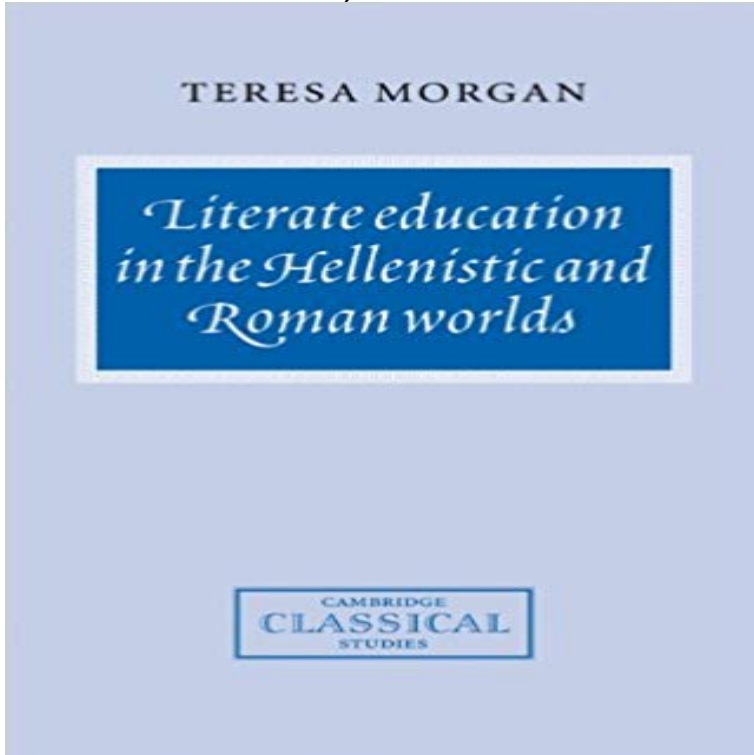


Literate Education in the Hellenistic and Roman Worlds (Cambridge Classical Studies)
