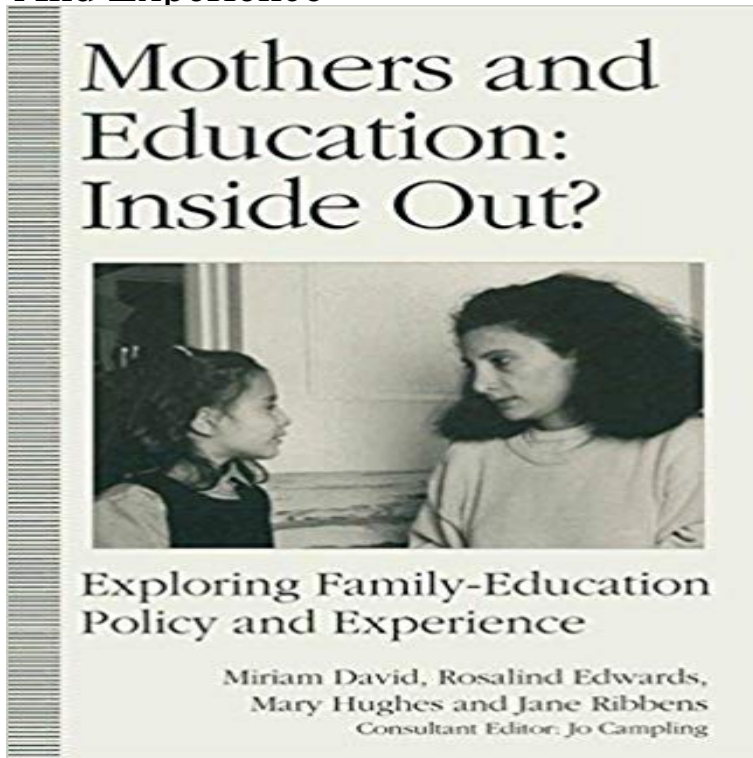


# Mothers and Education: Inside Out?: Exploring Family-Education Policy And Experience
