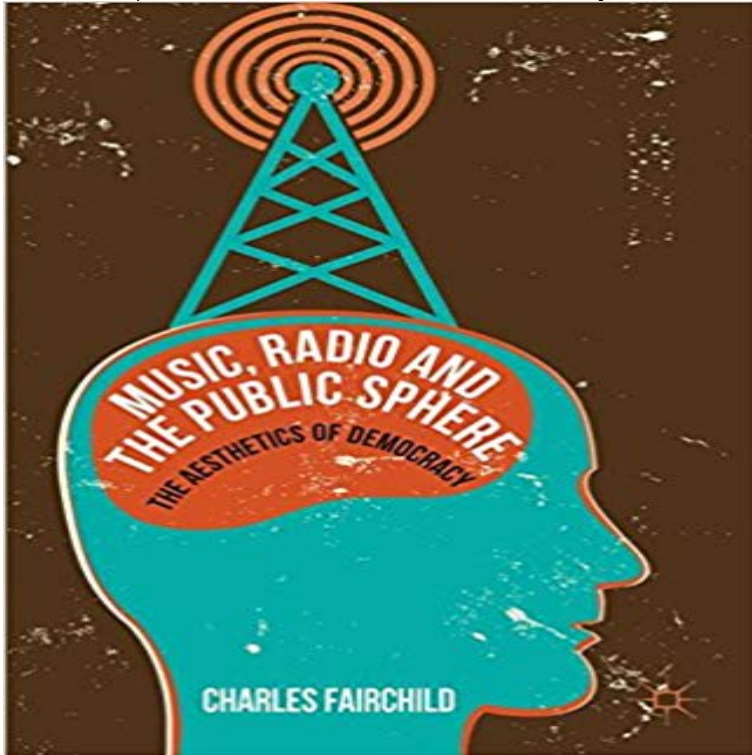


# Music, Radio and the Public Sphere: The Aesthetics of Democracy
