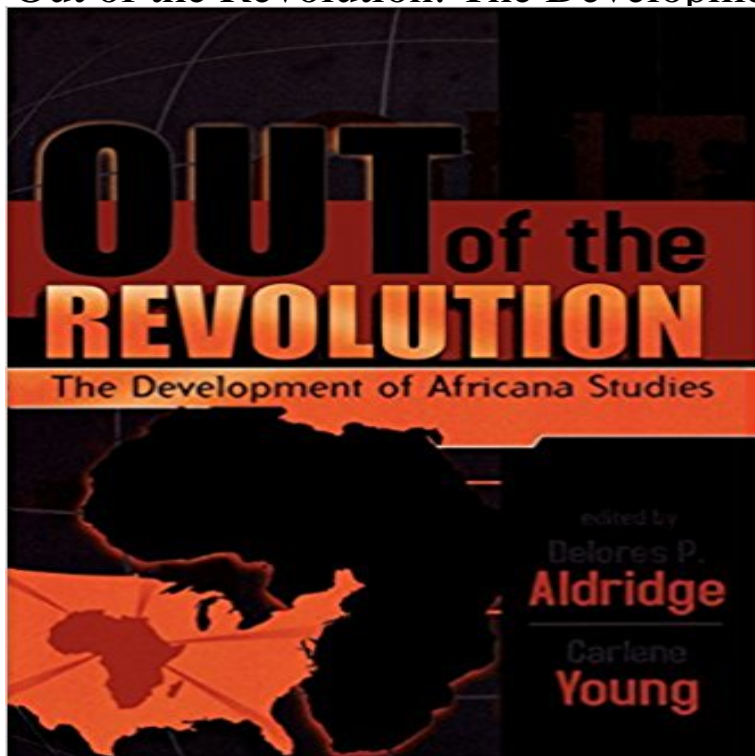


## Out of the Revolution: The Development of Africana Studies
