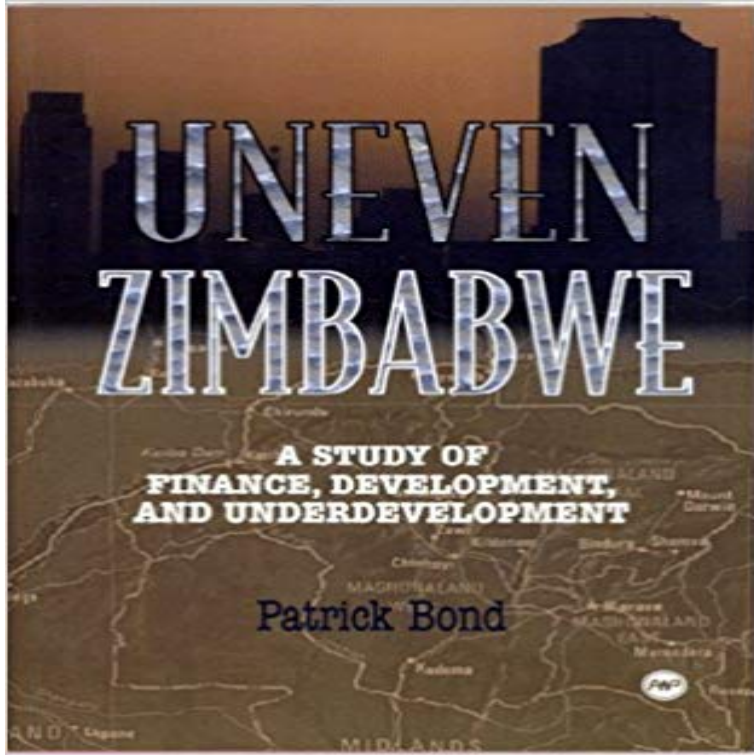


# Uneven Zimbabwe: A Study of Finance, Development and Underdevelopment
