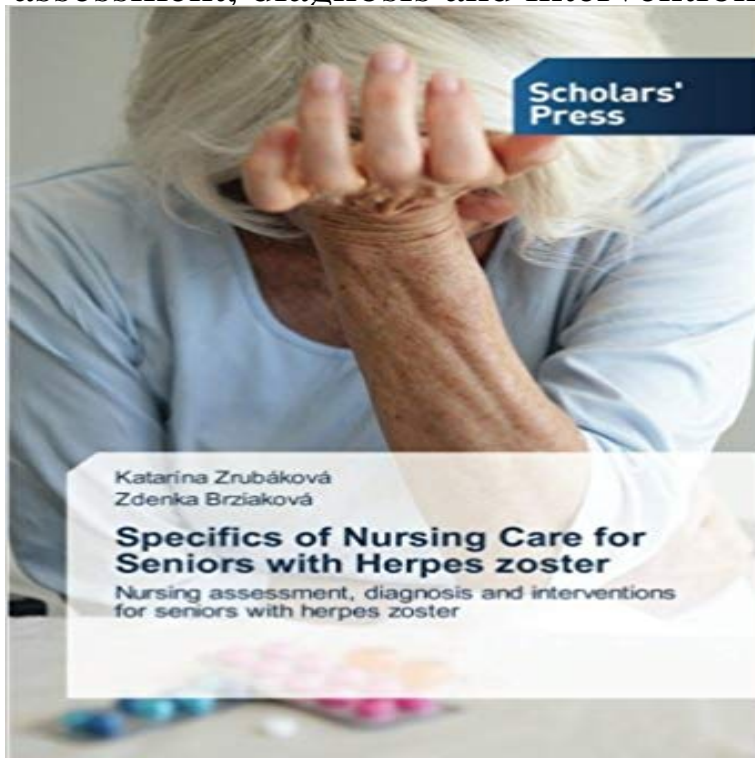


Specifics of Nursing Care for Seniors with Herpes zoster: Nursing assessment, diagnosis and interventions for seniors with herpes zoster
