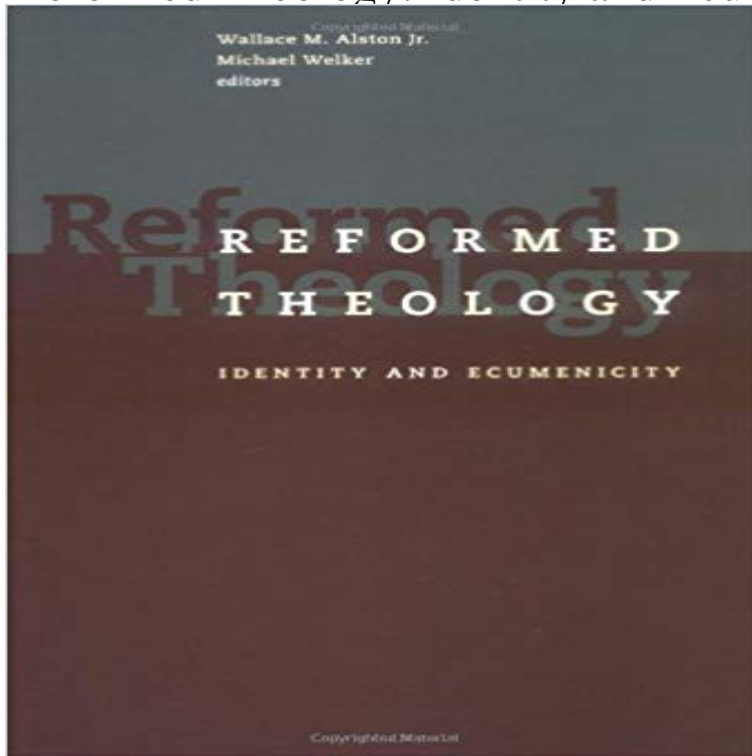


Reformed Theology: Identity and Ecumenicity
