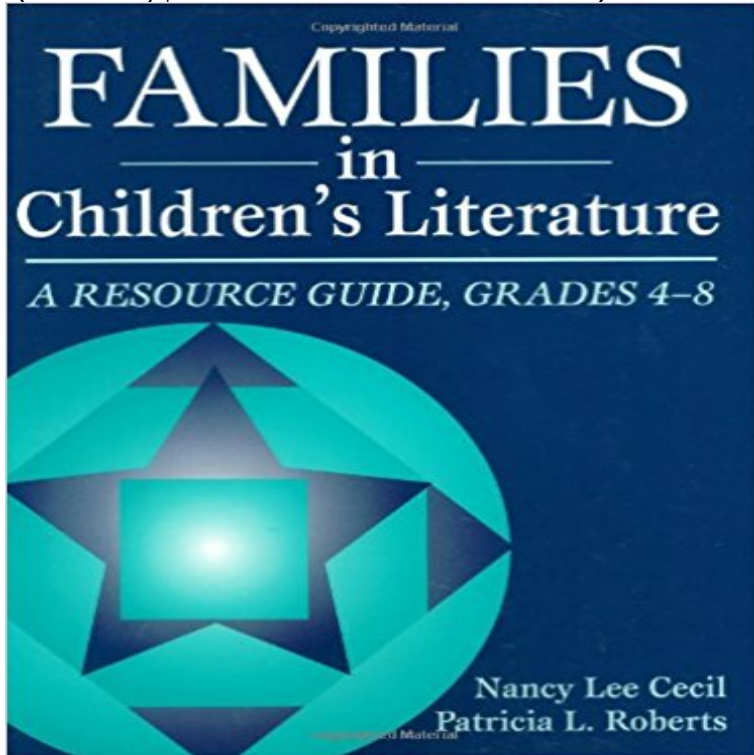


Families in Childrens Literature: A Resource Guide, Grades 4-8 (Through Childrens Literature)
