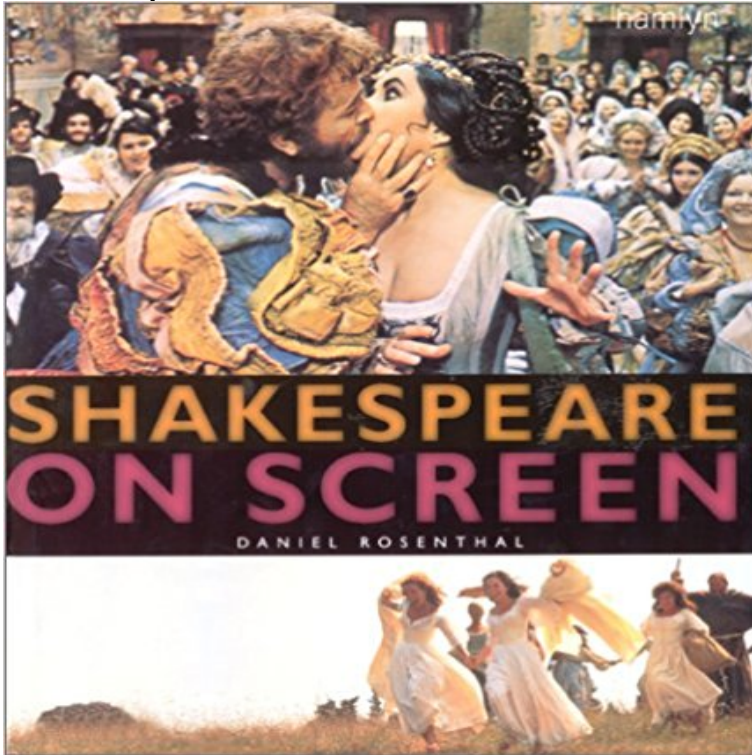


Shakespeare On Screen
