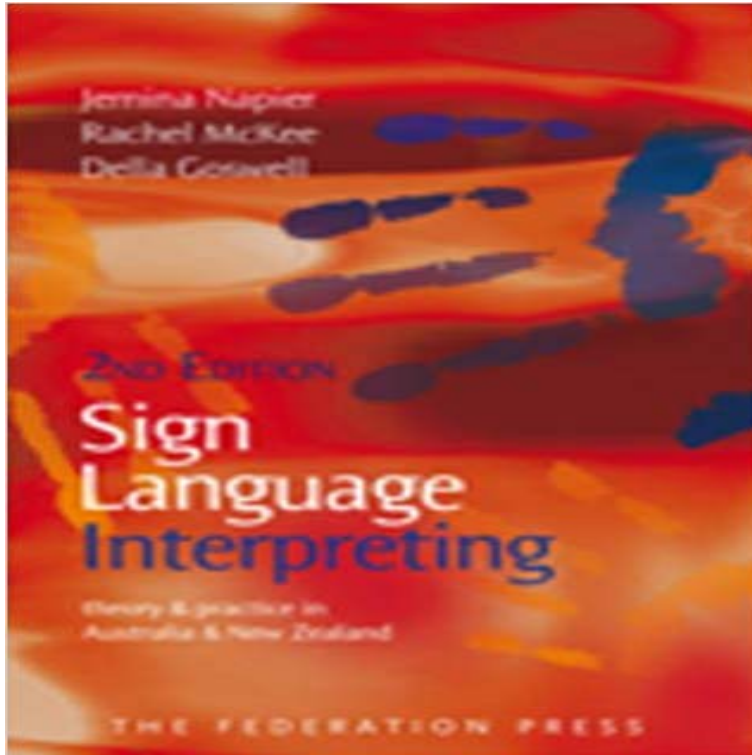


# Sign Language Interpreting: Theory and Practice in Australia and New Zealand
