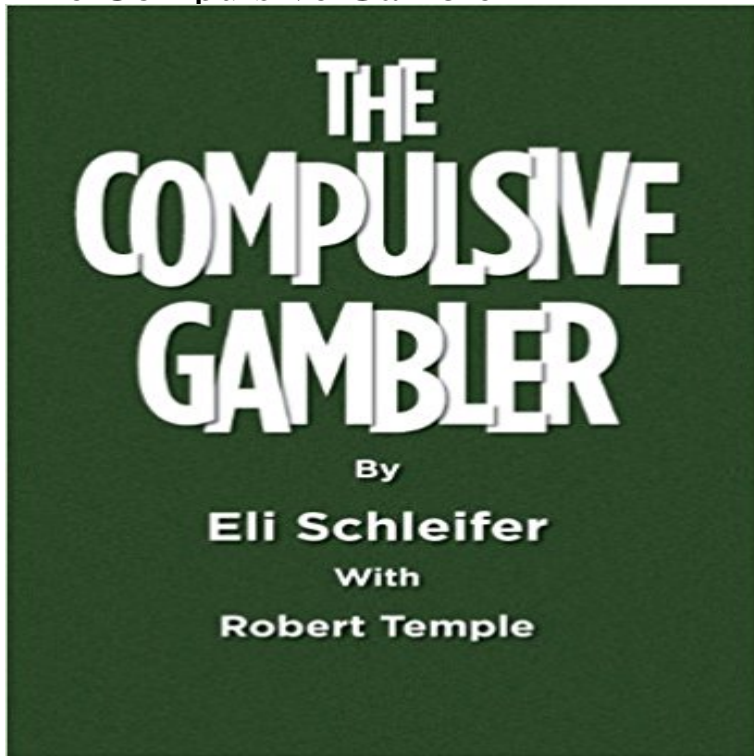


The Compulsive Gambler
