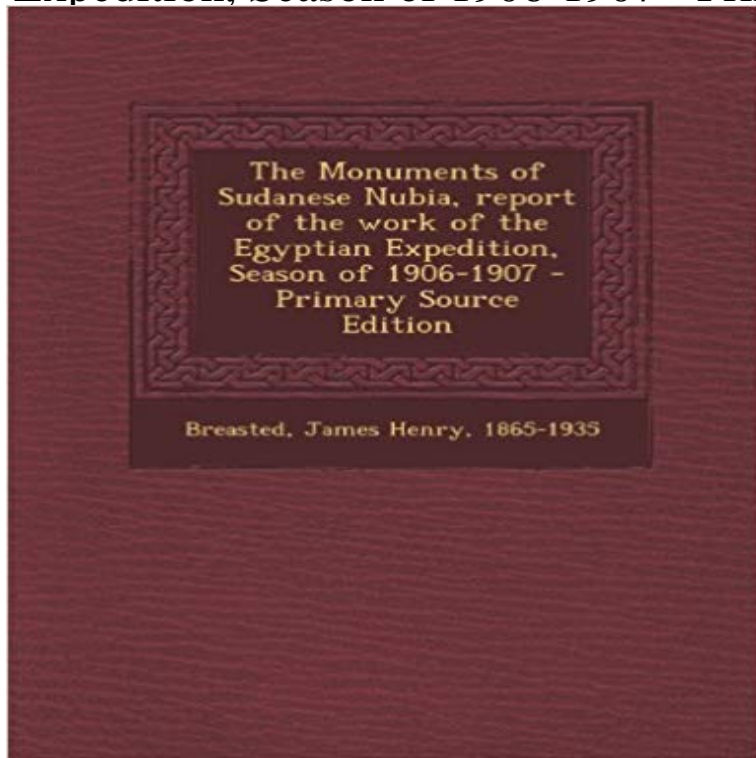


The Monuments of Sudanese Nubia, report of the work of the Egyptian Expedition, Season of 1906-1907 - Primary Source Edition
