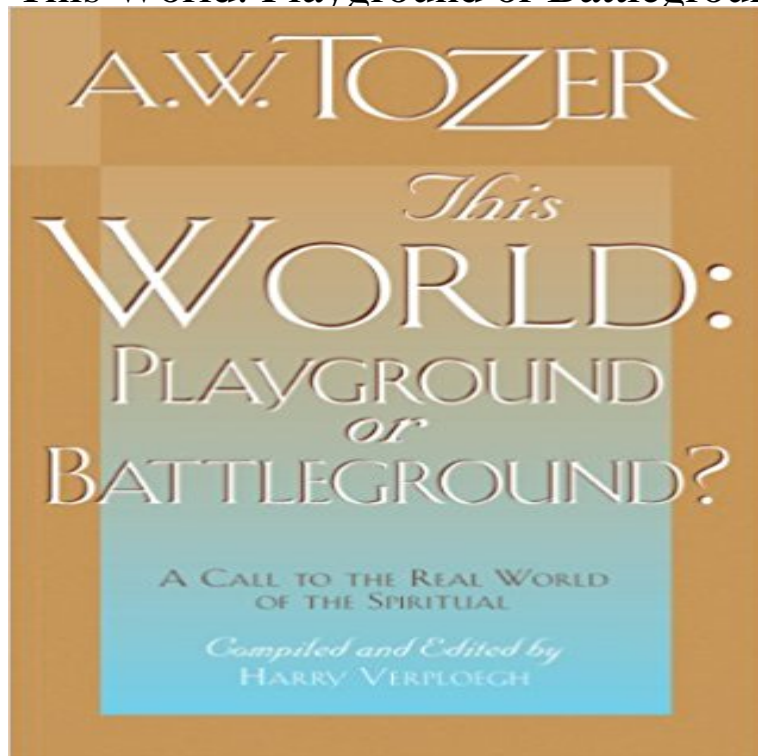


This World: Playground or Battleground?
