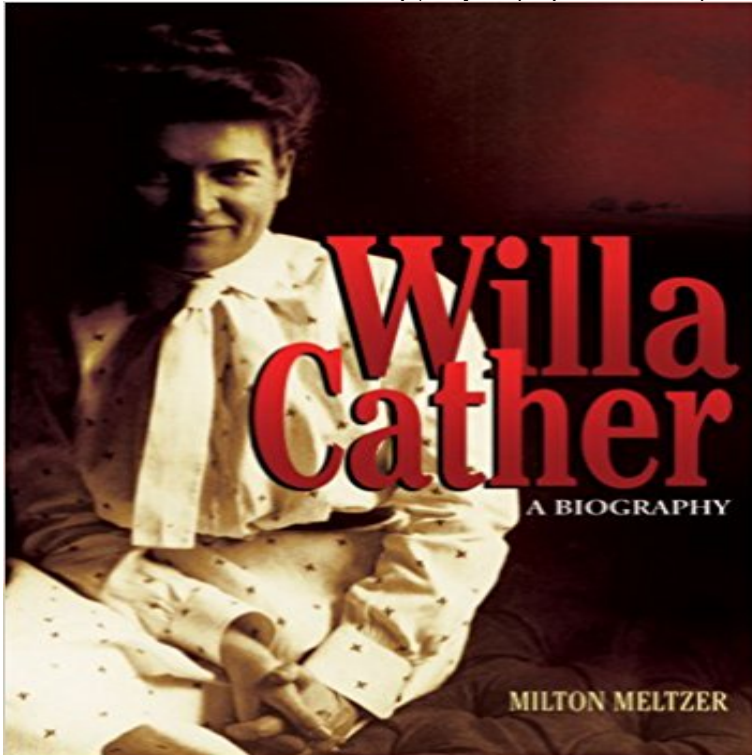


## Willa Cather: A Biography (Literary Greats)

Cather's story is one of a woman who carefully guarded her privacy while expressing her feelings and attitudes through the characters she created.
