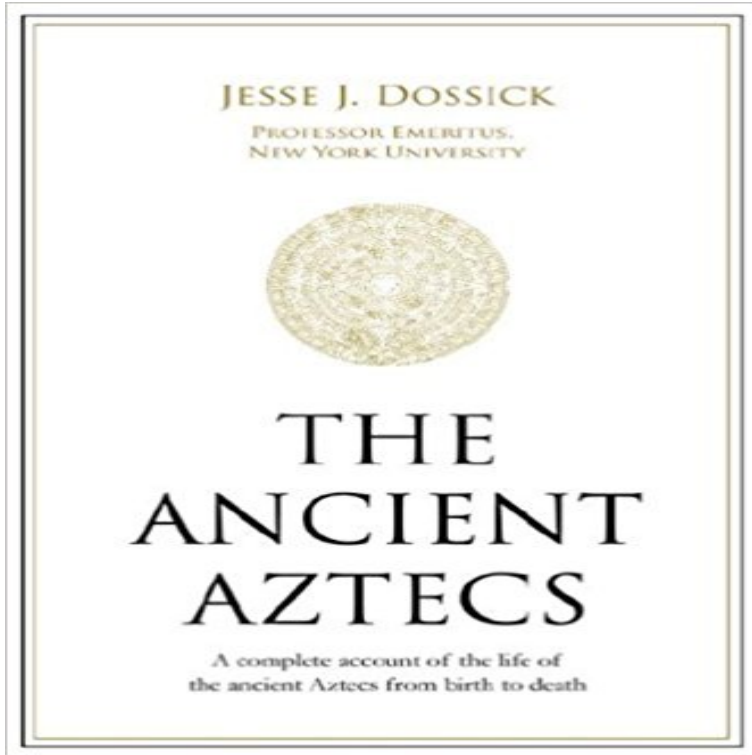


The Ancient Aztecs: A complete account of the life of the ancient Aztecs from birth to death
