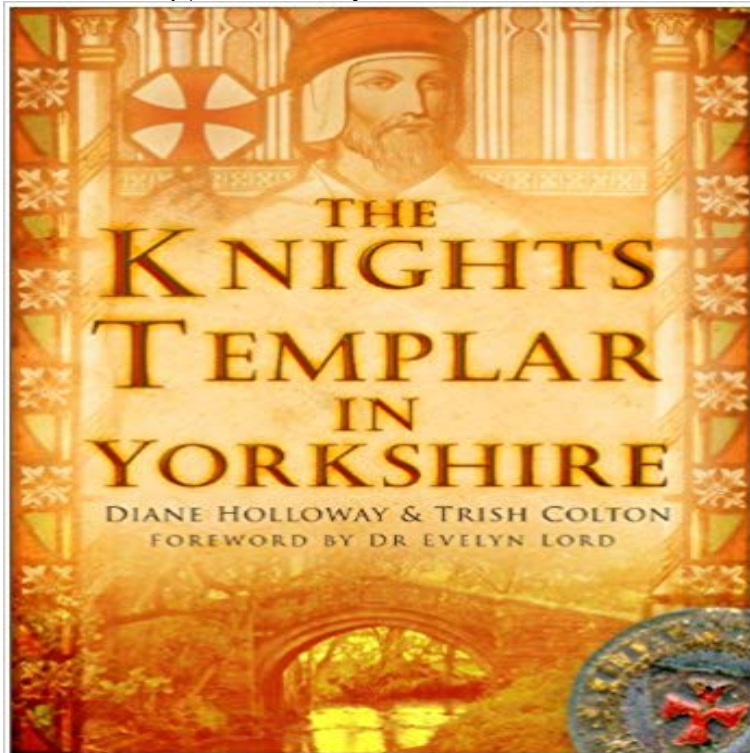


The Knights Templar in Yorkshire
